

Dear Partners:

We want to congratulate you on finishing the first year of the project; with successfully doing all activities required from us, we are now introducing the plan for the second year. We had a meeting with our agent in Brussel and informed them of the activities being done and our continuation activities in the project.

The plan and activities to be considered and amended according to the package plan:

1. Symposium: the symposium will be on 1.8.2022 -5.8.2022; the theme is Reconciliation, Conflict Transformation, and Peace Education. The meeting will take place at the University of Jena. Invited personals from each partner are as follows:

a. Professor research in the master program development

b. technical staff.

c. Administrator staff.

d. Two AARMENA Ph.D. students maximum.

2. We had a meeting with Brussel Agency, and they have stated that experts in the field from the program countries such Germany or Austria, needed by the partner country, must be paid by the partner country. Therefore, no amendments are accepted at this stage, not on the proposal or changing any personnel in the project.

3. Development working sessions: We can do another two workshops' sessions, as a state by many of the partners; according to the discussion took place 15.12.2022, that the first workshop would be Jordan, between 22.5.2022 and 28.5.2022, the Algerian Partner also offered two dates to do the workshop 28.5.-4.6 or 4.6.- 10.6.2022. As a coordinator, we propose the following: to have the Jordanian workshop in 22.5.2022 and the Algeria workshop from 4.6.2022 until 10.6.2022, because, we congratulate our Muslim partners on the month of Ramadan which is "April.2022" there will no hard activities in this month, we should conduct at least one online meeting in April for the management of the project.

4. Publications: Please participate in the AARMENA Symposium so we can publish articles for this AARMENA book; it will be titled Reconciliation, Conflict Transformation, and Peace Education. Emphasis on Peace Education, AARMENA has signed a contract with Springer for publication and Erasmus Plus office in Brussel was notified about this task.

5. Online AARMENA website: the official website for AARMENA until today is <u>www.aarmena.uni-jena.de</u>, which the Brussels agency accepted, and the University of Jena and the ministry of research in Germany accepted. We need that all parties send us the link for their AARMENA website so we can connect them. We must have the AARMENA website connected with all partners; <u>please send me the link</u>.

6. AARMENA (summer/Winter) school: we would like to introduce the Innsbruck Unite for Peace at the University of Innsbruck. They will work with us; we will teach this summer; the program starts in April, from 6.4. until June (2:00 pm -5:00 pm every Friday) obligatory for all of us to attend, we can make one Session 1:30 Hour for the Ph.D. Session and the other Session for developing the Master Programs, we will invite guest and speaker that are experts in the field in those sessions. Last year we invited the a Austrian Prince, and also a Professor from University of Brussel, spoke about Africa development with the EU. This year we will invite "Prof.Dr. Fanie Du Toit" Distinguish professors at the Merry Hoch Institute for Reconciliation at George Mason University - Washington DC.

7. AARMENA Campus: A Hybrid online campus, we are advancing in developing the online campus for AARMENA, which can be used by the Master Programs in the Partner countries and by the AARMENA Ph.D. in the program countries. That will substitute the mobile app because we can not do both.

8. Last in December, to have a winter school, we propose at the University of Innsbruck, the same partners that got invited Professors, Teachers, and Ph.D. students.

9. Equipment, all partners must submit the equipment purchase and by them before July, as we will work on the technical report for the project and equipment purchase must be in the report, three universities worked on purchasing the equipment, there is another three we need information for equipment purchased.
